

## About the Solar Waffle Works

When you patronize our business, you are not just getting tasty waffles, you are also giving a better education to local youth and job training to adults who participate in Port City programs. The Solar Waffle Works (SWW) food cart is a non-profit operation run by the SolTrekker non-profit in partnership with Portland Public Schools' Community Transition Program and Port City. SWW was designed by young adults in the PPS Community Transition Program to be a socially responsible business and training program. SolTrekker recently partnered with Port City to open exciting job skills development opportunities to adults who participate in Port City programs. All proceeds from waffle sales support local education and fair wage employment! This project was originally funded by SolTrekker, Portland Public Schools and the Spirit Mountain Community Fund.

SWW sources the majority of our food within a 200 mile radius. This coming summer we are excited to offer seasonal fruit from the Port City North Portland Farm for a SUPER LOCAL waffle option! The Port City North Portland Farm is the urban chemical-free biodynamic farm located at our North Williams and Tillamook location. We currently use 200-watts of solar modules to run about 25% of our electrical load. Our goal is to continue adding modules as our budget allows and to further develop our relationships with local farmers and food producers.

SWW provides hands-on education in starting a socially responsible business. Students and adults gain food prep, customer service and business management skills, and education in sustainability. At the same time, they gain community connections.
